

- Approved Purchase and Sale Agreements for two future elementary school sites; one in Mississauga and another in Brampton.
- Cont nued addit ons, renovat ons and improvements at 27 schools in preparat on for the implementat on of Year 4 of the Full-Day Kindergarten program.
- Secured approval from the Ministry of Education to invest in the board's capital priorities projects.
