

The Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB) has received funding to rebuild the existing St. Anne Catholic Elementary School (SE). The contractor is currently mobilized onsite and demolition of the existing building is imminent. Part of the demolition includes removal of the existing fence that surrounds the property. Once the existing fence is removed, a temporary construction fence will be installed. A new permanent 1.8 m (6 ft) black chain link fence will be installed near the end of project completion.

Fence removal will take place on Monday February 26.
